

#### **FA Statement**

Taking into account the survey results and the ongoing impact of Covid-19, which continues to adversely affect incomes for clubs due to restrictions on both spectators and hospitality, The FA's Alliance and Leagues Committees have reached a consensus that subject to the approval of FA Council, the 2020-21 league season for Steps 3-6 of the NLS should be curtailed with immediate effect, with no

further league matches taking place this season.

#### SSML Statement 4<sup>th</sup> March 2021

Following the earlier email regarding the curtailment of League fixtures for this season, as has been said at club meetings previously, we will consider this, but we awaiting further information from the FA/DCMS on the question of whether spectators will be allowed and from what date, as this is currently unclear. It was the general view of clubs that income from spectators was needed to make it an attractive proposition. It appears that secondary income for the sale of alcohol outside will be allowed from 12 April, but not until 17 May inside clubhouses

We need to assess the interest from clubs in their wish to play in a cup(s), so that preparations can be made, hopefully in advance of a decision to admit paying spectators. WOULD YOU THEREFORE PLEASE REPLY BY 14 MARCH IF YOU INTERESTED, OR NOT, IN PLAYING IN A CUP COMPETITION AND LATEST THE COMPLETION DATE YOUR CLUB WOULD BE HAPPY TO ACCEPT. **The Clubs Officers will be replying to the SSML today saying yes to organize a competitive competition.** 

#### EJA U16's, U14's and SCYFL U18's

The EJA have asked for interest from clubs and a Zoom meeting is planned next week to discuss how to continue the season. The SCYFL have also asked the clubs their views on what they would like to do with the rest of this season.
