# WELCOME TO PANCAKE LANE

## AFC HAYES

AFC Hayes changed the name of their senior teams from Brook House Football Club at the end of season 2006/2007.

The club was formed in 1974, springing from local Saturday sides Charville and Hayes North.

Success soon followed in the lower divisions of the Hayes and District Sunday League culminating in winning the Middlesex Sunday Junior Cup. Success continued with two League and Cup winning doubles before a switch to Saturday football in 1982 joining the now defunct South West Middlesex League.

Brook House then became founder members of The Middlesex County League before they joined the London Spartan League in 1989 when they were awarded senior status. In their first season, despite not finishing in one of the two promotion spots they were promoted to the Premier Division.

In 1992 the club had their floodlights erected, and to mark the occasion, Chelsea were the first opponents under lights at Farm Park. In the same season, the final of the Spartan League Cup was reached, but Cheshunt took the trophy.

With the advent of their lights, the club was able to enter the FA Cup, and on two occasions they have reached the first qualifying round, most notably in 1995/1996 when they held Conference side Stevenage Borough to a 0-0 draw away only to lose the replay at home.

For the kids Brook House have always been noted for their thriving Youth Teams and in 1997 they appointed Mickey Harvey as manager with the express purpose of linking the Youth and Senior set ups. The move proved very successful as in its first season the club were Minerva Spartan South Midlands Premier Division (South) champions and in the following season the under 18 side won their section of the Allied Counties Youth League and then became champion of champions.

In 1999/2000 the club were runners up in the Premier Division of The Spartan South Midlands League and were Premier Division Cup winners. The reserve side won the Middlesex County League and Cup double and gained entry to The Suburban League for season 2000/2001.

The following season they won their geographical division and were promoted to The Premier Division.

At the end of the 2001/2002 season, manager Mickey Harvey decided to try pastures new, with Bob Strutton taking over.

2003-2004 saw all the hard work and belief in younger players pay off, and we were never out of the top three in the league, eventually achieving second place. The lads also won the Challenge Trophy and were runners - up in the Premier Cup. Having just missed out promotion to the new National Step 4, we were invited into the Ryman Isthmian League Division 2.

In the close season, Bob decided to call it a day, so the Club again promoted from within. Joe Mitchell as manager with Colin Murphy as assistant and head coach.

2004-5 was a very good year - 3rd in the league and last 16 of the FA Vase, the Reserves won the Middlesex Premier Cup on penalties and were still in the Suburban Premier. In 2005/6 we won the last ever Isthmian League Associate Members Trophy beating Hertford 3 - 1 in the final.

In the League we eventually finished third on goal difference behind Ware and Witham Town, but that placing and the E Level ground -grading saw us promoted to the newly -formed Step 4 Level and into The Southern League South & West Division.

After a promising start to the season we had a very indifferent second half, but we managed to achieve our main ambition of staying at this level. The highlight was coming runners-up in the Middlesex Senior Charity Cup.

From 2007-2008 the club started with the new name for our senior sides AFC HAYES. The Youth section are still carrying on our historic club name.

The 2008-2009 Season was the most successful season to date and the team finished 7th in the Southern League. This was overshadowed by winning the Middlesex Senior Cup for the very first time in the club's history. A 2-0 win over Hendon brought the trophy back to Farm Park.

The 2009-2010 season will start with a new management team of Dale Welch, assisted by Thomas O'Donoghue and Terry Welch in what we believe to be a very bright future for the club.

During the next few seasons AFC Hayes consolidated in the Southern League and challenged for the Division One Central play-offs in 2011-12.

In 2012-13 we appointed Ian Crane who has rebuilt the team he was joined by Graham Goode as assistant but on in early December 2014 Graham left us followed by Ian's resignation after xmas 2014

.We appointed Paul Palmer and his assistant Colin Brown quickly, hoping to turn it around but that didn't happen he did not have enough time and relegation was the result and a place in the Combined Counties Football League Premier Division.

After an indifferent season some good and bad results we agreed to part company in November 2016 and Sean Berry a well known local x player has taken on the role as Manager until the conclusion of this season with assistant Alan Galloway,

Both Sean and Alan Galloway continued into Season 2017-18 with Sean resigning early season we appointed Alan Galloway and Dave Kennedy as joint managers for the remainder of the season where we finished in a disappointing position.

Allan Galloway was appointed manager for season 2018-19 he has brought in Terry Scholes a well known figure in local football as his assistant and James White also joined the staff along with the evergreen Terry Welch

Leverstock Green opened their league season with a defeat as they went down 3-1 at Aylesbury Vale Dynamos on Tuesday night. It was mostly an evenly-contested game, but the home side proved more clinical in their finishing.

Sidney Gueye had the game's first chance in the 5th minute for Leverstock, but his shot from the edge of the box went just wide. Matt Fallon was forced into a save in the 11th minute, and two minutes later produced a double save as Leverstock struggled to clear a corner.

Luke Peerless got on the end of a free kick in the 15th minute, but his header was comfortably saved by home keeper Archie Davis, and Davis gathered again in the 29th minute when Micky Shuttlewood dived in to meet a free kick with a header. Seconds later the ball was at the other end, and a shot from Lamar Mason-Williams took a deflection off a defender which took it just out of Fallon's reach and into the corner of the net to give Aylesbury a 1-0 lead.

The second half proved a similar story, as Leverstock had another chance in the 47th minute with Guiseppe Delgaudio getting on the end of a free kick, but again it was saved by Davis. Three minutes later the home side doubled their lead, and it was unfortunate for Jamie Ovington, as his attempted clearance cannoned off of Daniel Lambeth, who then won the race for the rebound and was clean through to slot home the second goal.

In the 59th minute Davis pulled off his best save of the night to tip over a close-range shot from Shuttlewood that looked certain to put Leverstock back in the game.

A third goal for Aylesbury six minutes from time sealed the match, as Leverstock were caught short at the back after a mistake, leaving Alfie Gaspar all alone to slot home from the edge of the box.

There was a brief glimmer of hope in the 87th minute when Leverstock pulled a goal back. Shuttlewood won a challenge with Davis in the box, and as the ball came down, he hooked it over the keeper into the net. Aylesbury were reduced to ten men in stoppage time when Dave Brown was shown a straight red card for a two-footed tackle on Elgeniy Daalberg, but there was no time left for Leverstock to take advantage

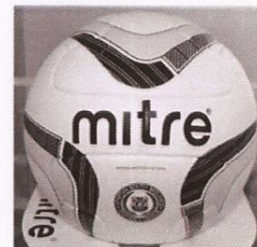

Leverstock Green's run in the FA Cup ended in disappointing fashion as they were beaten at home by Hellenic League side Burnham in Saturday's Preliminary Round tie. A couple of injury time goals made the scoreline a little flattering for the visitors, but overall they looked the better side against a Leverstock side that didn't create enough today.

Burnham had the first attempt on goal, with Manny Williams bringing a save out of Matt Fallon in the 13th minute, but two minutes later it was Leverstock who took the lead. Brima Johnson's ball into the box found Ollie Cox, who finished well with a shot from a narrow angle which beat the keeper and went in off the far post.

However, the lead only lasted for three minutes, as Burnham equalised through Rashid Hamid, who was allowed too much space to turn and hit a shot from distance that flew past Fallon. The remainder of the first half saw more fouls than scoring chances as the game became increasingly competitive and reached the break with the scores still level.

There continued to be little in the way of chances as the second half progressed, with the referee often being busy as the game threatened to boil over. Burnham had more of the ball going forward, but they had only produced one save from Fallon in the second half before taking the lead in the 72nd minute. Manny Williams got on the end of a cross from the right to head home from close range.

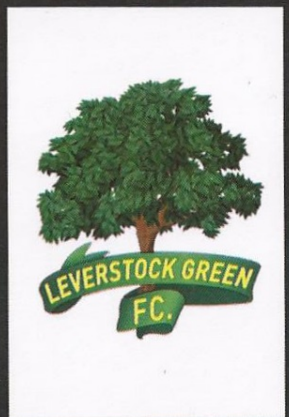
Leverstock forced a few corners as they pushed for an equaliser, but they were unable to force the Burnham keeper into any kind of save. They were still in the game as the match went into stoppage time, but Gavin James put the game beyond their reach as he ran unchallenged through the Green defence to shoot home the third goal in the second minute of stoppage time, and there was a virtual action replay three minutes later as James ran through again to score the fourth

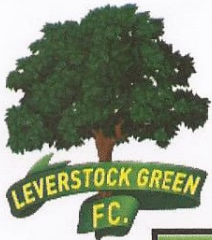
