**G**ood afternoon to you all, today we welcome the Players,

Officials and Supporters of Edgware Town Football Club.. We also welcome today's Officials the Referee Mark Bright and his assistants Trevor Gregory and Gavin Muge. With our first league game after the recent shutdown in front of eighty-one spectators at Pancake Lane we took on previously unbeaten Colney Heath but having to play for eighty-five minutes with ten men we secured the three points with a three-two win. Our next first team game is on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> December at home to local rivals Tring Athletic with a 3.00pm kick-off. All rescheduled first team games are shown in the programme. On Tuesday evening the Under 18 team made the short journey along to Vauxhall Road where they took on Hemel Hempstead Town and came away with all three points in a four one win. Their next game is on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January at home to Kings Langley. The club would like to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and stay safe.

## WELCOME TO PANCAKE LANE EDGWARE TOWN

The club were founded in 1939 and played in the Middlesex Senior League until joining the Coronian League in the 1946–47 season. In 1948 they won the Middlesex Senior Cup. In 1963 the club transferred to Division One of the Athenian League. They finished third in their first season, and were promoted to the Premier Division. In 1966–67 they finished bottom of the division, and were relegated to Division One. This was followed by a second successive relegation to Division Two as they finished bottom of the table again.

In 1972 the club was renamed Edgware. When the Athenian League disbanded in 1984 they joined the London Spartan League before changing their name back to Edgware Town in 1987. They won the Premier Division of the Spartan League in 1987–88 and 1989–90, and after their second title win, were promoted to Division Two North of the Isthmian League. After league re-organisation in 1991 they were placed in Division Three, which they won the following season. They were relegated back to Division Three in 2001.

In 2006 the now-renamed Division Two was disbanded and Edgware were transferred to the Premier Division of the Spartan South Midlands League. They won it at the first attempt, also winning the Premier Cup and the Challenge Trophy. The club was promoted to Division One North of the Isthmian League, but folded at the end of the 2007–08 season due to lack of funds.

In 2014 a group including Dan and Antony Manzi, Daz Bloor and Ken Batten secured the club's inclusion back into non-league football. After a shaky start to the 2014–15 season,

the club finished a credible 9<sup>th</sup> and Middx Prem Cup Runners up after the management team of Michael Roche, Fabio Valenti and Peter Grant came in.

The 2015–16 Season saw “The Wares” finish top with only 2 defeats, and lose in the Divisional Cup Final to Crawley Green.

The ground, Silver Jubilee Park has achieved a C grade rating with 3 new stands, new floodlights and extended changing rooms and new perimeter fence. The Ken Batten Stand should be in place shortly and then SJP will have 2 seated stands, 3 standing covered stands with a capacity just shy of 2000. Fabio Valenti took over as 1<sup>st</sup> team manager in June 2016.

Fergus Moore took over the team in 2017 after the departure of Fabio Valenti, and after a difficult start the team finished 10<sup>th</sup> which showed a marked improvement from the season before.

The 2018–19 season was another midtable finish with Fergus pretty much on his own but towards the end of the season he was joined by Joe Pascoe who came over from the Hendon U18's and that's how the 2019–20 season will begin.

The 2019–20 season was cut short because of Covid19 but before that happened the Wares were looking pretty good for a top 10 finish in the league, having started the season well the team went through a horrible period losing 13 of their next 14 games before recovering to win 6 of their next 9 games. The 2020–21 season starts with the return of our title winning manager Michael Roche as Fergus's assistant and also arriving on the coaching staff are Scott McGleish, Glen Parry and Julian Darby.

Preheat oven to 200 degrees.

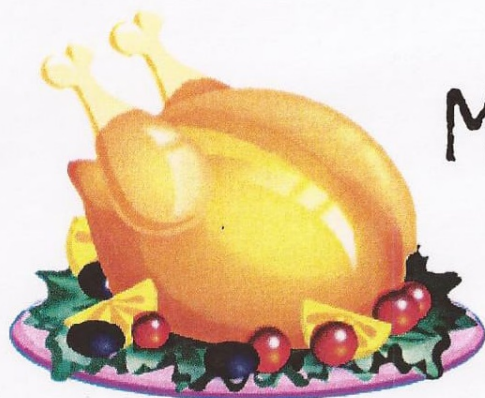
Brush chicken well with melted butter salt and pepper.

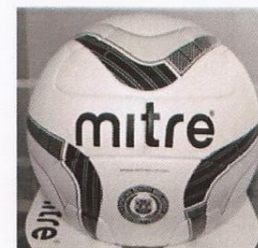

Leverstock Green 3 Colney Heath 2**

Leverstock Green returned to league action after lockdown, and did so in magnificent style, ending the unbeaten league record of local rivals Colney Heath despite having to play for 85 minutes with ten men. It was a genuinely deserved result for a battling team performance on a pitch which was left quite heavy after the rain during the week.

The game was in just its fifth minute when Leverstock were reduced to ten men. Luke Peerless reacted to a challenge from Jay Lovell with hands to the face, and although there was little contact, it was in full view of the linesman, and the referee had little alternative but to show a straight red card.

The visitors had the chance to take the lead in the 8th minute in a goalmouth scramble following a corner, but James Hall cleared off the line. Leverstock's first effort on target came in the 17th minute as Adiel Mannion hit a shot from a narrow angle which former Green keeper Matt Evans turned round the post. Two minutes later Evans was in action again, turning a long-range free kick from Jamie Ovington round the post.

However, it was Colney Heath who took the lead in the 29th minute, as Harry Shepherd got to the bye-line and sent over a cross which found Heath skipper Jack Woods to head home the opening goal.

Leverstock were not disheartened by the goal, though, and hit back four minutes later when Frank Jowle curled a cross from the edge of the box towards the far post where Kian Wilkes slid in to net the equaliser from close range.

The visitors could have gone back in front on 38 minutes when Shepherd was clean through on goal, but pulled his shot wide of the post. Instead it was Leverstock who got their noses in front on 41 minutes. Hall delivered a great cross into the box which Jowle headed towards goal, and Ovington applied the finishing touch into the net as the ten men of Leverstock went into the break with a 2-1 lead.

There was still much work to do in the second half as Colney attacked down the slope. Four minutes in Matt Fallon had to make a great save to keep out a header from Marcus Mealing. However, on the hour mark Mealing got on the end of another cross from the right and this time headed home the equaliser. Ovington almost put the Green back in front five minutes later with an acrobatic overhead kick, but Evans saved. On 70 minutes John Smith got a yellow card for a challenge on Mealing just outside the box, and Mealing's attempt from the resulting free kick took a deflection off the wall and went just wide.

Leverstock brought on two new young signings in Isiah Noel-Williams and Michael Gabblah, and Lewis Collins was also introduced in the 72nd minute. Five minutes later Leverstock broke away and Collins received the ball on the halfway line before pushing forward and passing to Jowle. A slip by a defender left Jowle clean through, and he showed his experience with a composed finish, slipping the ball under Evans to put Leverstock back in front at 3-2.

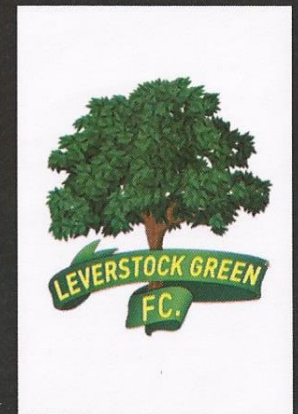
The ten men continued to hold steady at the back over the closing minutes, with Mickey Shuttlewood being particularly impressive against his former club, as the visitors put on the pressure, and after five minutes of stoppage time the final whistle put the seal on a tremendous result for Matt Harding's side

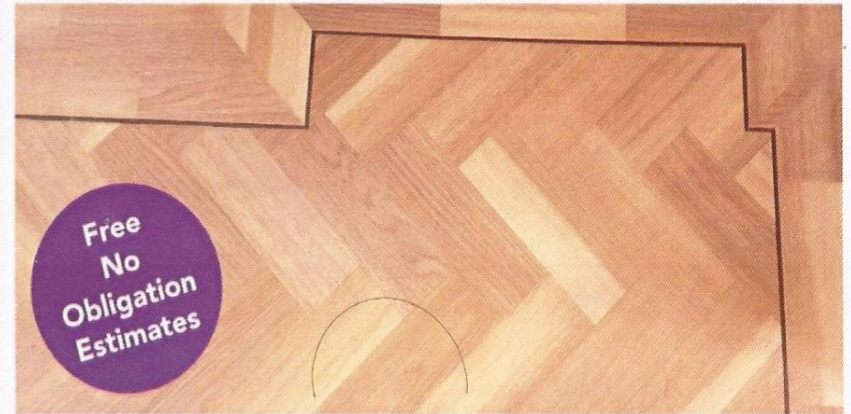

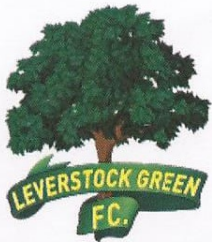
