Good afternoon to you all, today we welcome the Players, Officials and Supporters of Harefield United Football Club.. We also welcome today's Officials the Referee Stuart Smith and his assistants Noel Glavin and Gavin Muge. The first team got the defeat at Colney Heath out of their system and took on a strong Newport Pagnell Town team at Pancake Lane and ran out winning by two goals to one. On Tuesday evening it was behind closed doors at The Brache which is Luton Town's training ground to take on Crawley Green which proved to be a night of despair having been reduced to ten men in the first half with a red card then playing with nine for another ten minutes due to a sin-bin plus a penalty we came away with no points in a four – two defeat. On Thursday evening the Under 18 team took on Langley at Pancake Lane and what a game against a very good team and the supporters were treated to a goalfest with the visitors running out winners by five goals to four.

WELCOME TO PANCAKE LANE HAREFIELD UNITED

The club was formed in 1868, making it the oldest club in Middlesex. In their formative years they played under such names as Harefield Victoria and Breakspear Institute in the local Uxbridge Leagues before merging with Harefield FC in 1934 to become Harefield United, playing in the Uxbridge and District League.

By 1947 the club had joined the Great Western Combination, playing at Taylors Meadow and winning the league once in the 1950-1 season. In 1964 the club moved to the Parthenon League, winning the league at the first attempt. They then joined the Middlesex League two seasons later where they stayed for five seasons, winning the league title four times and the league cup twice.

In 1967-8 the club celebrated their centenary by moving to their present ground at Preston Park in Harefield, joining the Spartan League Senior Section in the 1971-2 season, staying there for four seasons, making their debut in the FA Vase in 1974-5 before progressing to Division Two of the Athenian League for the 1975-6 season. The club also made their debut in the FA Cup in 1979-80. The Athenian League folded in 1984, the year the Hares won the League Cup under manager Nobby Carpenter, making them still the current holders!

The club then moved to the Isthmian League Division Two North for two seasons, then spent seven years in Division Two South before being relegated to Division Three where they stayed until after the 1996-7 season when lack of funds for ground improvements meant the club had to move back to the Spartan League. A year later they became founder members of the Spartan South Midlands Premier Division South, until it was renamed Division One where they finished runners up and won the League Cup, before playing in the Spartan Premier where they remained until being relegated to Division One at the end of 2015-6. This spell was the most successful in the club's history winning the Challenge Trophy in 2002-3 and the Premier League Cup the following season when they were also runners up in the Middlesex Senior Charity Cup. Under manager Stuart Leavy the Hares were league runners up twice, in 2006-7 and again in 2008-9 when they missed out on promotion to the Ryman League by one goal difference to Biggleswade Town.

In 2002 Harefield United Youth FC was formed with teams from the former Denham Youth FC, the club currently fielding over twenty teams of all ages and levels from Under 7s to Under 21s, Sunday League teams, Under 18s Allied Counties, reserves and first team with some players having progressed all the way through the ranks.

In 2010 the club won the National Award for Groundsman Of The Year for Steps 5 and 6, some achievement for a club with no groundsman and the pitch maintained by volunteers.

In season 2016-7 the club played five FA Cup ties and won the Middlesex Cup, finishing eighth in Division One.

In season 2017-18 the Hares promoted former first team player Ben Payne to Head of Youth Development, looking to expand the thriving youth programme further at Harefield. The club now have teams at every age group, several girls' sides and run a Mini Hares session on Saturday mornings for Under 4 and 5s.

In 2018 United celebrated their 150th year of football in Harefield as a community club promoting senior, junior, Sunday and women's football. The same season 2018-9 Manager Jason Shaw gained promotion in his fourth campaign by going unbeaten all season, only dropping four points and winning 34 consecutive matches, also winning the Middlesex Premier Cup against a strong Cockfosters side.

"The Invincibles" started the 2019-20 season back in the Spartan South Midlands Premier Division, a return to Step 5 football, a season that was expunged due to the Covid 19 virus. The Hares introduced a ladies side for the first time, managed by former Reserve team coach Vince Bairda with his coach Brian Keeley, and were looking good for promotion before the season was curtailed.

Jason Shaw now looks to begin his sixth season with the club with the Hares playing Step 5 football again, here's to the next 150 years!

Crawley Green 4 Leverstock Green 2
Tuesday 13th October 2020

Ill-discipline and defensive errors contributed to Leverstock Green suffering a 4-2 defeat at Crawley Green in a game played behind closed doors at The Brache on Tuesday night. Despite playing with ten men for two-thirds of the game and with nine men for a ten-minute period, they were never out of the game until the very end.

There was a debut for Thomas Littleboy, who signed a couple of weeks ago but had been unable to play until now due to a five-game suspension picked up at his previous side Amersham Town.

The home side took the lead in the 8th minute through one of the first mistakes of the game, as Kian Wilkes gave the ball away outside his own box, and Phil Draycott hit an angled drive into the bottom corner of the net. However, Wilkes made up for his error in the 15th minute as he received a pass from Steve Hawes and hit a tremendous shot from distance which also found the bottom corner of the net to level the scores at 1-1.

Matt Fallon denied Draycott a second goal in the 21st minute as he dived to his right to turn away a free kick. Leverstock's task was made harder in the 36th minute when they were reduced to ten men. The referee adjudged that Littleboy had deliberately stamped on an opponent and showed a straight red card to bring his debut to an early end.

Four minutes before half time the Leverstock ranks were reduced even further. Fallon appeared to be fouled by an opponent and when Brima Johnson protested to the referee he was sin-binned for dissent.

The nine men made it to half time with the scores still level, and through the opening six minutes of the second half, during which Fallon made an excellent close-range save from Jonathan Barnett. However, within seconds of Johnson rejoining the game Danny Watson shot home a second goal for Crawley Green to put them back into the lead.

There was a chance of an equaliser on 61 minutes when Oran Swales crossed into the box for Frank Jowle, but Jowle couldn't get enough on his shot to trouble the keeper. Two minutes later a foul by Jamie Ovington on Sam Holmes gave the home side a penalty, which Watson tucked away to put Crawley Green into a 3-1 lead.

Leverstock still weren't out of the game. In the 67th minute a determined run from Luke Peerless was brought to an end by a foul just outside the box. The result was a free kick in a similar position to that which Peerless scored from on Saturday, and once again he found the net, this time without a deflection as he lifted the ball over the wall into the top corner to pull the score back to 3-2.

A double substitution on 74 minutes saw Leverstock switch to 3-5-1, and for the remainder of the game it was end-to-end. Fallon produced another great save to deny Mark Bunker on 82 minutes, while three minutes later a curling shot from Swales was saved. However, two minutes into stoppage time another error at the back saw Fallon throw the ball out to Swales with an opponent in close proximity who won the ball and crossed to the far post where Draycott headed home the goal that sealed the win for Crawley Green

Leverstock Green bounced back from their midweek disappointment at Colney Heath to score a late winner of their own, clinching a come-from-behind victory against a strong Newport Pagnell Town side. The visitors are likely to be one of the title contenders this season, and the Green side put in a very determined and hard-working performance, soaking up a lot of pressure but coming out on top.

There was a debut in the Leverstock line-up today for Oran Swales who has joined for a month-long loan from Berkhamsted, and it proved to be a very impressive debut.

Leverstock made a good start to the game as they attacked down the slope, but it was the visitors who took the lead in the 12th minute. After Josh Crawley's free kick from just outside the box had been deflected wide by the Green wall, the resulting corner was crossed into the six yard box where Christian Smail headed home.

However, their lead only lasted five minutes. Brima Johnson played a short free kick to Swales, who ran on with the ball before cracking a low drive from outside the box into the bottom corner of the net for the equaliser.

Newport Pagnell went close again from a corner in the 36th minute as Crawley flicked the ball onto the roof of the net, while Leverstock had a near miss just before the break when Luke Peerless curled a shot from a narrow angle just wide.

The visitors were attacking down the slope in the second half, and had a couple of chances in the opening five minutes with James Sage heading over from a corner, and Crawley shooting over the bar after being set up by a good move. On 52 minutes they came even closer when Jimmy Burnside hit a rasping shot which cracked against the crossbar after Matt Fallon got fingertips to it.

Newport Pagnell continued to dominate possession, with Leverstock at times struggling to keep the ball out of their own half for more than a few seconds. However, the Green side was in no mood to give anything away, and their determination plus some calm and composed defending meant that the visitors did not get any further direct strikes at Fallon's goal.

With eight minutes to play and the game still tied at 1-1, Sidney Gueye was brought down by a challenge on the edge of the "D". The result was a free kick in a dangerous position, and Luke Peerless took full advantage as he hit a shot which took a deflection off the wall and flew into the net to put Leverstock into the lead.

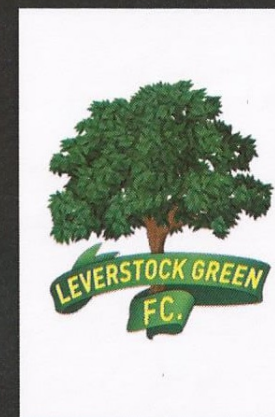
Cass Grant had a chance to make the game safe in the 90th minute, but his shot went wide. However, the 2-1 lead proved to be enough for Leverstock to take the three points. There were outstanding performances all across the pitch, particularly from Jamie Ovington and Connor Church in his first full game of the season, but the star performer was 17-year-old Kian Wilkes in midfield

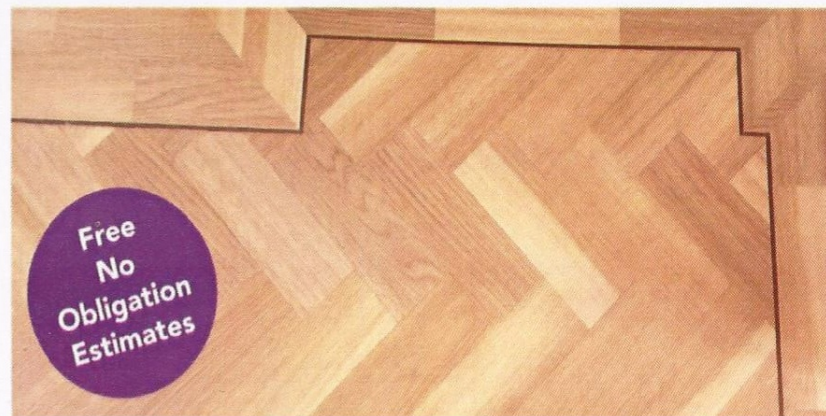

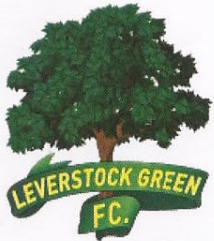
