What an excellent display from the Under 18 team when they travelled to Windsor in the FA Youth Cup returning with a five goals to one win. They now have their first home tie in the competition when on Thursday 8th October they are hosts to Wealdstone.

NORTH GREENFORD UNITED

The club was founded in September 1944 as a youth team. The following season saw the formation of a senior side with the club entering the Harrow League and later the Middlesex County League. In 1983 the club was promoted to the Spartan League but in 1994 it resigned to re-join the Middlesex League. Keen to regain Senior Status, ground improvements were undertaken, including the installation of floodlights, and in 2002 the club was elected to the Combined Counties League.

In 2003/04, managed by Steve Hawkins, the club were runners up in the Premier Challenge Cup losing 4-1 to AFC Wimbledon in front of a crowd of over 5,000 at Woking FC. In 2004/05 the club finished League runners-up and in the following year reached the League Cup semi-final. In 2006/07 the team, under Mick Harvey, went one better, but unfortunately lost 4-1 to Merstham in the final.

Steve Ringrose took over the Manager's job at the beginning of season 2008/09. In his first season Steve led the team to second place in the Premier League with the club finishing Runners-up to Bedfont Green. Season 2009/10 proved the most successful in the club's history when the First Team became Combined Counties Champions, earning promotion to the newly-formed Southern Football League Division One Central, as well as winning the MFA Charity Cup beating Enfield Town 1-0 at Hampton & Richmond's ground in front of a large crowd.

Despite having a difficult first season at the higher level the First Team succeeded in retaining its Step 4 status. However, despite notable cup successes, the first half of season 2011/12 saw the club struggling in the league. Steve Ringrose was replaced by Neil Shipperley in December 2011 and Shipps managed to successfully steer the side away from the threat of relegation.

Experiencing an even more difficult time at the start of season 2012/13, Neil Shipperley was re-appointed for a second term replacing Jon-Barrie Bates as First Team Manager. However, the team continued to struggle and, having lost 14 league matches on the trot, our only consolation was that Woodford United had still failed to notch up a single point. Our campaign that year was saved by an amazing end-of-season run which saw the team finish 19th – above the relegation places.

We were hoping to continue where we left off at the start of the following season but, again after excellent cup runs, we struggled in the league and narrowly escaped the drop after crucial wins against our two fellow relegation contenders, Chertsey and Ashford Town (Middx). Reserve Team Manager Paul Palmer, supported by Don Bennett, replaced Shipps following Neil's resignation midway through the season.

Following an indifferent start to the 2014/15 campaign it was decided to part company with Paul and ask Don to take over. Results though did not improve and in December 2014 Don tendered his resignation. Reserve Manager Barry Morris took over assisted by coaches George Bouhet and Fitzroy McLeod. After an initial struggle another impressive end-of-season run saw the team finish four points clear of bottom club AFC Hayes, and we were granted a reprieve by the FA.

Barry and his team were re-appointed for the forthcoming campaign, but in September Barry resigned and George took over. Unfortunately, poor results again left the club rooted at the bottom of the table, and in November 2015 the committee appointed two ex-Greenford players – Ricky Pither and Danny Bennell – as joint First Team managers to replace George. Despite some promising performances, results still did not improve and four wins and six draws were not enough to secure the points needed to avoid the drop. On this occasion there was to be no chance of another reprieve.

We were offered a place in the Combined Counties Premier Division after successfully appealing against an FA decision to place the club in the Hellenic League and, with their wide knowledge of local clubs and players, Ricky and Danny's team were invited to continue in their roles, with Mark Chandler taking over as joint manager following Danny's resignation. Unfortunately, due to poor league results which left the club languishing at the foot of the CCL Premier Division table, the NGU committee reluctantly decided to part company with Ricky and Mark at the beginning of October 2016.

The experienced management team of Danny Vincent and Colin Murphy were offered and accepted the position, and were duly appointed in time to take charge of the Chertsey Town home game on 11th October. After the poor start the club eventually finished the 2016/17 season in a creditable 13th position on 58 points, and with Danny and Colin still in charge, assisted by Terry Schofield who had joined the First XI management team, we were looking for a higher finish the following season.

Unfortunately, after an excellent start with a fine FA Cup away win against Welwyn Garden City, during the earlier part of the 2017/18 campaign we became the league's draw specialists dropping points in games we should have won. From the turn of the year the season will be most remembered for some of the worst weather conditions in living memory with the season extended to the second week in May 2018. Despite ending the campaign on a high with four wins on the spin, overall 2017/18 was a disappointing season with the team again finishing 13th but with fewer points than the previous year.

Two major changes were then forced on the club during the close season. First last season's management team unexpectedly resigned and this was followed by an FA decision to move us to the Spartan South Midlands Football League Premier Division. On the management side we were quick to re-appoint Paul Palmer and Matt Penfold who had just won promotion from the SSMFL Division One with Southall. Neither Paul nor Matt were new to the club. Matt served here for two terms under Neil Shipperley and Paul took over from Shipps after his resignation in February 2014. With the experienced squad they brought to the club, we had high expectations at the start of the 2018/19 campaign.

Unfortunately, these were not realized and the team became embroiled in a relegation fight. Although wins against Leighton Town, Edgware and Biggleswade United helped secure our survival as a Step 5 club, a 16th place finish with just 34 points on the board left the committee with no choice but to make managerial changes. Following an impressive interview and an extremely successful 2 seasons as Under 18's manager the decision was taken to offer the First Team post to Colin Jones a position which Colin, supported by his full Youth management team, accepted. The full management team, led by Colin, remain in post, with Dino Pashias taking over the role of Youth Team manager, hoping the re-run of the Covid-19 abandoned 2019/20 season will lead to a much improved league performance!

Windsor 1 Leverstock Green 5
FA Youth Cup 1st Round Qualifying

Leverstock Green's under-18 side turned in another fantastic display to progress to the Second Round Qualifying of the FA Youth Cup with a convincing 5-1 win at Windsor on Monday night, adding to the seven goals they scored in the previous round.

The team made a bright start to the match, with Frankie Bircham hitting a shot just over the bar in the 6th minute. In the 27th minute David Emiloju hit a shot just wide, while 2 minutes later Ben Payne was clean through. The keeper made a good save to keep out Payne's shot and his effort from the rebound went wide.

The deserved goal finally arrived on 32 minutes. Lewis Nicholls crossed from the left, and though Payne couldn't quite get on the end of it, Emiloju was following in behind and shot home.

The lead was doubled five minutes later. A great pass from Jaylan Hector put Nicholls in on goal, and he shrugged off the attentions of a defender to slot home confidently for his fourth goal of the competition so far. It got even better in first half stoppage time when Emiloju was brought down in the box and Nicholls netted the resulting penalty to send Leverstock into the break with a 3-0 lead.

Payne could have made it four within 13 seconds of the restart, but shot over the bar after a defender headed the ball into his path. On 56 minutes Alfie Bigg struck a free kick from outside the box which was tipped over the bar by a keeper.

A straight red card for serious foul play reduced Windsor to ten men on 63 minutes, but their side seemed to play better with ten men than they had with eleven. After a spell of pressure, Windsor pulled a goal back in the 82nd minute when a cross from the right was netted from close range.

They could have pulled another goal back but for a couple of impressive saves from Leverstock keeper Lawrence Knowles. However, the Green nerves were settled on the break in the 87th minute when substitute Leo Broom ran clean through to slot home the fourth goal. There was further icing on the cake in the 90th minute when two substitutes combined, as Phoenix Chambers crossed and Broom swept in at the near post to clip home his second goal.

There was a worrying moment at the end of the game when a clash of heads left Emiloju with a nasty-looking facial injury, but hopefully he will make a quick recovery. Leverstock's reward for this impressive win is a home tie against Wealdstone in the Second Round Qualifying on Thursday 8th October

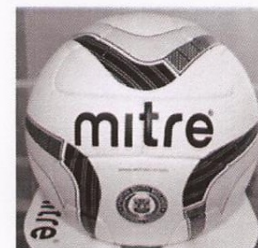

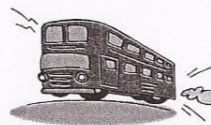

Leverstock Green's FA Vase hopes were ended at the first hurdle as a poor display saw them well beaten at home by Combined Counties League side AFC Hayes.

The first half was evenly-contested, with both sides having a number of half-chances. Matt Fallon made a couple of saves in the opening 15 minutes to keep the visitors out. Mickey Shuttlewood headed just wide from a corner in the 22nd minute after Sidney Gueye had threatened down the right. Three minutes later Luke Peerless got on the end of another corner but his header also went wide. On 31 minutes Adiel Mannion won the ball from a defender and ran on to square the ball into the six yard box, but Gueye couldn't quite get to it before the keeper. Mannion had the ball in the net with a great finish on 41 minutes, but the linesman had already put the offside flag up.

It looked like the teams would go into the break deadlocked, but deep into stoppage time Leverstock were attacking with a long throw into the AFC Hayes box, but were then caught short at the back as the visitors broke away quickly, and Shawn Wheeler connected with a cross from the left to shoot home a crucial goal on the stroke of half time.

The second half was a major disappointment as Leverstock seldom looked like getting back into the match. The task became even harder on 58 minutes when they were caught on the break again from their own free kick, and Trey Ponder-Brown shot home a second goal for AFC Hayes. A third goal struck by Wheeler on 64 minutes ended the tie as a contest, although AFC Hayes ended the tie with ten men after Theo Alexander was sent off for a second yellow card in the 90th minute.

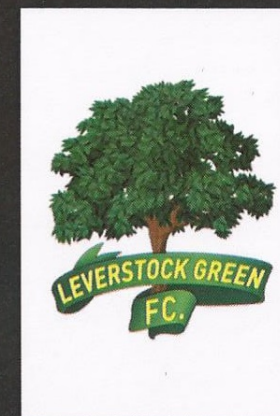
After three straight defeats, Leverstock now have ten days before their next match, which is a home league match against North Greenford United
