

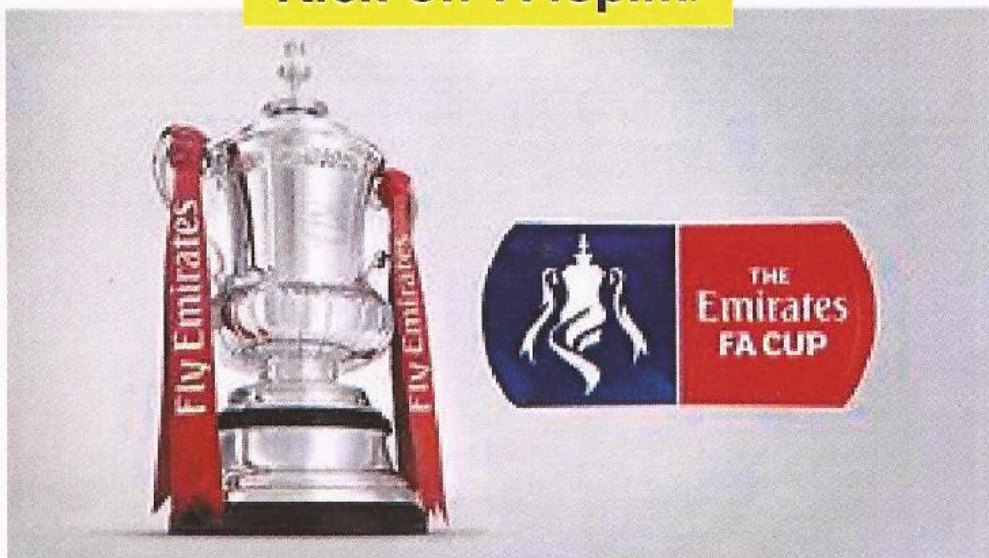

In these wacky times it was not required to publish a programme so it was decided to do a short version for this FA Cup game.

Could we ask that everyone observes the COVID19 regulations and keep social distance as required and enjoy the game as supporters would have seen that a number of pre-season friendlies had to be played behind closed doors.

HISTORY OF VALE FARM WEMBLEY

Within a year of Wembley FC playing at Vale Farm, a petition was presented to the council for an enclosed ground and eventually the authorities relented. With Vale Farm enclosed, Wembley was able to take gate money but the future of the venue as a Non League ground was not assured until 1951. That was the year the club presented a document outlining the clubs ambitions and the council was so impressed they offered the club a 21-year lease with the option of developing the ground. And the club wasted little time in erecting terracing, a small enclosure, a stand, floodlights and revamping the pavilion, bar and dressing rooms.

The pitch was always renowned for its excellent condition so much so that England trained on it during the 1966 World cup finals. Everything with Vale Farm was rosy and in the 70s a further 30-year lease was secured and the club appeared to be one of the most stable in NonLeague football. However, disaster struck and a fire threatened the very existence of Vale Farm. The main stand was gutted and the covered terrace was condemned. However, local builder Brian Gumm, the club chairman worked tirelessly to re-build the ground into the Vale Farm we see today. The remaining terrace was covered and 450 bright red seats were added to make up the tidy main stand now in place. The site of the old stand was concreted over and is now a very pleasant area to stand and watch the action

Sarratt 0 Leverstock Green 5

Leverstock Green won their first friendly of this pre-season, and it was a convincing win away to SSML Division Two side Sarratt with the side finding their scoring boots to hit five goals without reply.

Adiel Mannion hit the Green side's first effort on goal in the 11th minute, his shot being turned wide by the home keeper. In the 20th minute a pass from Dan Weeks put Mannion through to take the ball round the keeper, but the ball ran too far ahead of him and was cleared off the line by a defender. However, from the resulting corner, taken by Ollie Cox, Ollie Lawford got up at the near post with a glancing header to open the scoring.

On 25 minutes Green keeper Matt Fallon punched the ball off the line from a Sarratt corner, and as Leverstock broke away, Mannion had a run at goal but his eventual shot was saved. The second goal came in the 35th minute from a well-worked move which ended with Mannion squaring the ball across goal for Lawford to notch his second with a neat finish.

The front two combined again on 39 minutes as Lawford curled over a cross which Mannion got on the end of, but could only chest it onto the bar. Two minutes later there was another great cross from Brima Johnson, which found Luke Peerless, but his header went wide. In first half stoppage time Lawford completed his hat-trick with a shot from the edge of the box which the keeper should have done better with.

One change was made at half time, and a further six changes with half-an-hour left, and the substitutes produced just as impressive an attacking display as the first half side had done. Elgeniy Daalberg was denied by the keeper after being let in by a defensive mistake on 65 minutes, and two minutes later the livewire Daalberg hit a shot from distance just wide. Kian Wilkes was also just wide with a long-range shot on 72 minutes.

There were more near misses before the deserved fourth goal arrived on 82 minutes. A free kick from near the corner flag was not cleared, and the ball dropped for Shibli Miah to turn and shoot home from the edge of the six-yard box. Three minutes later it was 5-0. Daalberg was denied by a save from the keeper, who also kept out a follow-up effort from Paplamin Jawara, but the rebound went back to Jawara, who finally buried it.
